

UPDATED INFORMATION (As of August 24)

【For all visitors to JAPAN】

It was announced today that Japan will **end the 72-hour pre-arrival Covid-19 test requirement** for inbound travelers on Wednesday **September 7**.

*Please note that this new measure only applies to travelers who have been vaccinated **three times**.
More details will be announced in September.

【For Nationals of Canada and the United States of America】

From August 18, **Canadian nationals and U.S nationals** are able to apply for a short-term stay visa for the purpose of Business(Note), Visiting Relatives and Tourism(Note), on JAPAN eVISA web site <https://www.evisa.mofa.go.jp/index>

(Note)The certificate for completion of registration to the Entrants, Returnees Follow-up System (ERFS) which receiving organization located in Japan applied for online is required.

Eligible Applicants

Canadian nationals residing in Canada, American nationals residing in the U.S.

(Applicant are required to log onto the Japan eVisa website and display “Visa issuance notice” at the airport. PDF data or screenshot of the page will not be accepted.)
